What to Bring: Campers should bring their own gloves, bats and helmets. They should be dressed in athletic attire. Sweatpants or baseball pants are preferable, and spikes are the desired footwear. Please note that all participants are responsible for their own belongings.

Other Benefits: All players will receive free lunch daily and a free t-shirt included with the camp fee.
